ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Arizona, Art. 6, Sec. 24, A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 91 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, it is

ORDERED that Myra Harris is hereby appointed as a Court Commissioner of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, effective May 1, 2001, on a full time basis, with the working title of "Hearing Officer".

ORDERED that Myra Harris shall have all such powers and duties pursuant to law which shall include, but not be limited to, those powers and duties prescribed by A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 91, Rules of the Supreme Court, as amended.

ORDERED that Myra Harris is assigned to hear any matter within the purview of her powers pursuant to law.

ORDERED that Myra Harris shall receive compensation at an annual salary of \$51,922.50 total, pro rated for the balance of the 2001-year. This appointment is conditioned upon her agreement to serve only for the compensation received as a Court Commissioner/Hearing Officer, and to receive no additional compensation or benefit, fiscal or otherwise, when she acts in the capacity of a Judge Pro Tempore, unless funds are made available by the Administrative Office of the Courts.
