



MARICOPA COUNTY JUVENILE PROBATION

During this critical time, Judicial Branch operations at the Juvenile Detention Centers and Juvenile Probation Departments will continue in order to serve our mission of public safety through positive change. We are committed to supporting the safety and wellbeing of the public as well as the youth in our care. In order to reduce exposure to staff and our probation families during this health crisis:

- Our public lobbies and probation building locations are currently closed to the public.
- The Detention Medical Director has suspended in-person detention visitations until further notice.
- The Department is emphasizing the use of electronic forms of communication to continue to fulfill essential services.

Family contacts and professional visits will continue to be available by telephone. Detention is hard at work creating opportunities to facilitate video conferencing as another avenue for visitation. Parents or professionals may receive telephone calls from unknown numbers originating from our Detention facilities as Detention attempts to facilitate telephonic and/or video conferencing visitations. We ask that parents/professionals please answer those phone calls so they do not miss an opportunity to visit with their children.

If your child is currently supervised on probation or is in one of our detention facilities, please contact the assigned probation officer or consult this directory for more information prior to traveling to an area office.
