1. What is your understanding of what a Commissioner does?
2. Commissioners may have one assignment for an extended period of time. Assignments might include night/weekend calendars, and some assignments may be at locations such as the Sheriff's Intake, Transfer and Release facility or Maryvale Hospital. How do you feel about working such assignments, perhaps for an extended period?
